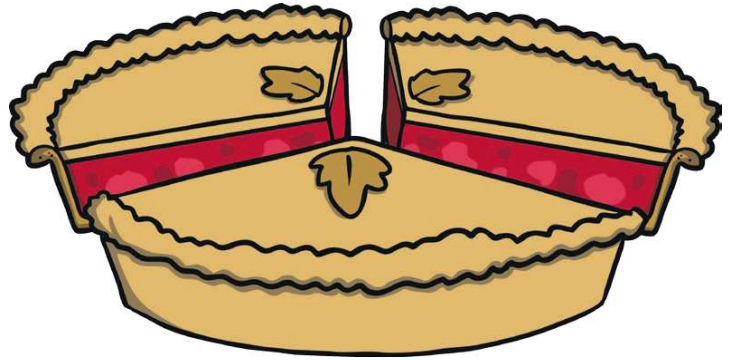


Author's Purpose

E: Entertain the reader with an interesting or funny story.



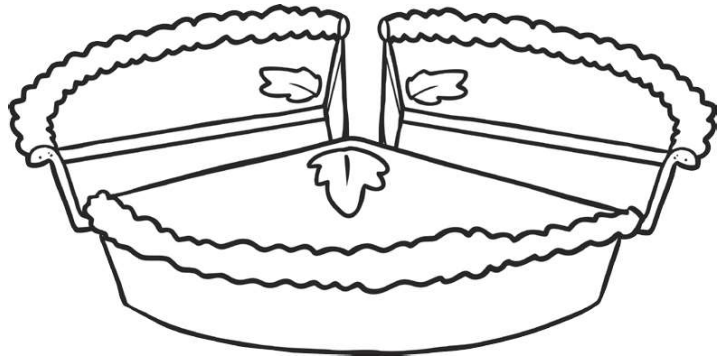
